



It is being observed that now-a-days laser beams are directed intentionally to aircraft during landing/ taking off or flying around the airports. High intensity rotating lights/ laser lights are indiscriminately being used for outdoor entertainment activities which penetrate into the sky. These lights/ laser beams adversely affect the eyesight of the pilots and is a hindrance to the safe conduct of flights. These types of activities hinder the flight operation endangering the lives of the pilots and on-board passengers. These activities will be considered as offence under Civil Aviation Act 2017 and the offender/offenders may be subjected to a maximum punishment of death sentence or life imprisonment and a fine of not more than Taka 5 (five) Crore. Under the circumstances all are requested to refrain from such activities with immediate effect and bring to the notice of the nearest police station about such activities.
